II. KIPLA Introduction

1. Foreword

Intellectual Property (IP) is a key issue for Korean companies and the nation as a whole. Particularly as Korean companies expand their global reach, IP related disputes have increased in number, significance and public concern. The highly publicized, multi-jurisdictional dispute between Samsung Electronics and Apple is a notable example.

In recognition of this growing importance of IP, the government passed in 2011 the Framework Act on Intellectual Property that both created a Presidential Council on Intellectual Property and set forth a national strategic plan. Other interested parties in academia, judiciary and industry have also been vigorously discussing the issues concerning IP for companies, individuals and the nation as a whole. There was, however, a growing need for a focused community of IP lawyers to further these discussions and to educate on IP issues.

The Korea Intellectual Property Lawyer's Association (KIPLA) was formed in 2014 to fill this growing need. KIPLA is comprised of a representative group of law firm attorneys, in-house attorneys, academic professionals, government officials and members of the judiciary. Today, KIPLA provides a forum for discussion, serves to gather information and opinions from the community, and provides educational programs for new lawyers.

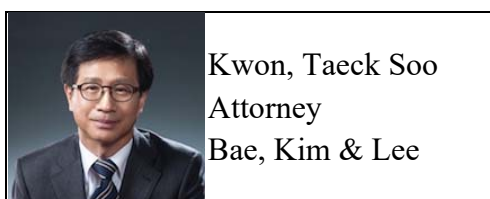

b. Committees

The Public Interest Committee

Organizes public events and provides Pro Bono activities, such as IP legal consulting or educational sessions for individual inventors, potential entrepreneur and students.

The Education Committee

Plans and organizes education programs for KIPLA members.

The International Cooperation Committee

Organizes and hosts international conferences and manages and maintains various relationships with international IP communities and organizations.

The Public Relation Committee

Provides opportunities for KIPLA members to interact with various local authorities and organizations such as the Korean Intellectual Property Office, the (Patent) Courts of Korea, the National Assembly, and Presidential Council on Intellectual Property. Also serves as a main public relation window for KIPLA.

3. Activities

a. Main Activities

- ***Domestic and International Conferences***

KIPLA hosts domestic and international conferences and invites IP related figures such as judges and lawyers from around world, creating opportunities for members to learn and discuss not only domestic IP issues but also foreign IP issues

- ***CLE Program and Educational Activities***

KIPLA provides monthly seminar and special lecture series for members and utilizes web-based media to promote communications between members.

- ***IP Policy and Advocacy***

KIPLA works closely with the Department of Justice, the Intellectual Property Office, and other governmental entities to promote and support various IP related legislations and policies. KIPLA has proposed IP related policies to the Intellectual Property Office and the Presidential Council on Intellectual Property.

KIPLA also works with the judicial branch. For example, KIPLA has offered opinions and presentations to the courts including the IP court on various IP related issues, e.g., damage calculation, hearing procedures, etc. KIPLA has also assisted the Supreme Court in relation to its efforts to establish new IP related judicial policies.

- ***Pro Bono and Public Services***

KIPLA provides various services to the public and law school students including lectures, moot courts, and free legal consultation sessions.
